This signature event was created in partnership with a dedicated group of volunteers who sought to enhance post-stroke rehabilitation by offering **Stroke Camps.**

Expansion allowed funding other rehabilitation programs such as Hippotherapy, Music-Therapy, a Brain Tumor Group and Camp, plus the renovation of our outpatient rehabilitation center.



The spectacular show pairs professional ballroom dancers from the *Arizona Ballroom Champions* with volunteers, to create a performance that tells the story of the exceptional care patients and families receive with Dignity Health.









Our Impact

Since the first year where volunteers gathered 8 dancers, 200 gala attendees, and one stroke camp was held...

- ✓ Over \$1million invested in equipment, training and therapy
- √ 10 camps total have supported survivors and their families
- ✓ Over 10,000 hours of support and therapy has been provided (groups, speech, music, hippotherapy)
- √ 36 dancers performed in support of the cause
- ✓ Over 1900 attendees were educated on stroke and brain injury


