Osama T. Niazi, DO is a cardiac electrophysiologist at Arizona Cardiac, Electrophysiology PLLC, Dignity Health Heart Arrhythmia Center, Chandler Regional Medical Center and Mercy Gilbert Medical Center.

Dr. Niazi is board certified in Internal Medicine, Cardiovascular Disease, Cardiac Echocardiography and Cardiac Electrophysiology. Dr. Niazi has expertise in ablation of supra ventricular, ventricular and atrial tachyarrhythmias. He also has expertise in implantation and extraction of cardiac implantable electronic devices. His research interest is in management of arrhythmias and is actively involved in the Heart Rhythm Society and the American College of Cardiology.

Dr. Niazi earned his medical degree from A.T. Still University of Health Sciences.
