## D-backs Fund Traveling Resiliency Room for East Valley Healthcare Workers



The Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation is investing in a mobile "Nurse Resilience Room." The traveling room will provide a space where hospital staff can take a break and recharge. This room will debut in early 2023 and will be equipped with massage chairs, a therapy table, adjustable lighting, sound and visual stimulation, and aromatherapy. The traveling room concept was conceived by leaders in the hospital as a way to reach the over 5,000 staff who work in all our hospitals, urgent care facilities and freestanding emergency departments. We are grateful for the Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation's support of our health care workers and are excited to debut the traveling room in the near future.



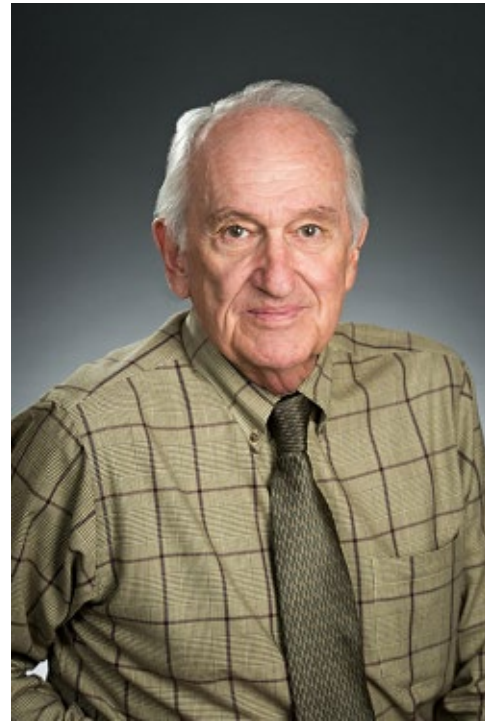
### The NICU Teams Memorialize Dr. James C. Zozobrado
