Thank you to our <u>golf sponsors</u> who became emergency response fund donors. And thank you to the many individuals donating PPE.



It's stocked with staple items like eggs, milk, cheese, flour, rice, beans and bread. It also has toilet paper, paper towels, dish soap and disinfectant available. The onsite grocery store isn't only a time saver, it also allows our team to practice social distancing by avoiding crowds at the supermarket.

Dignity Health East Valley Foundation supports Chandler Regional Medical Center (2,500 employees) and Mercy Gilbert Medical Center (1,800 employees) and accompanying urgent care centers. We have had many calls from community members wanting to directly support employees and their families. We are so appreciative of your care and concern for our team members. Here are a few options:

HERO Fund: Helping Employees Reach others can take donations to support employees who find themselves in financial need. Emloyees apply to the human resources department. (This is not considered by the IRS to be a tax-deductible gift.)

Kindness Market: Employees at the hospitals can shop on-site for essential groceries and household items. Your gift would enable the hospitals to continue to provide the essentials at wholesale cost to employees.

Meals for Caregivers: The Foundation receives your donation of gift cards from your favorite restaurant and gives them to the team leader to coordinate a safe time for delivery of commercially-prepared food.
